



ROLL-IN SHOWER FLOOR AND DRAIN DETAIL
SLAB ON GRADE CONSTRUCTION

Notes:

1. Prepare concrete slab as required by waterproof membrane manufacturer's suggested specifications.
2. For increased protection, waterproof membrane should be applied under the entire bathroom flooring.
3. Recess the slab of shower pan so the top of upper slab is higher than shower drain inlet (1-1/2" - 2" typical).
4. Slope shower floor 1/8"-1/4" per foot to drain.
5. Set tile in shower area in full mortar bed. Thinset application may be used over rest of floor.
